Introduction

The Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust was set up in July 2006, after the Hamilton City Council committed to build a hydrotherapy pool at Waterworld in Hamilton. They resolved in their Ten Year Plan to provide funding provision of \$180,000 in 2006/07 for the design of a hydrotherapy pool and to contribute 33% of the capital funding to construct the pool. The Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust has taken on the task of raising the community's contribution of \$M1.2 of the cost (\$M2.4)

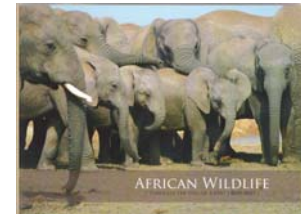
