The Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust would like to thank the following for their recent grants towards building a hydrotherapy pool in Hamilton.

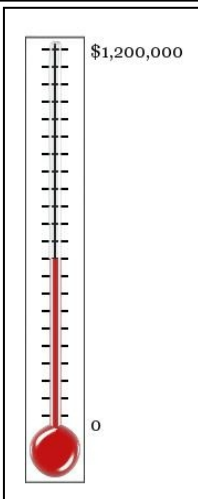

The Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust was set up in July 2006, after the Hamilton City Council committed to build a community use, hydrotherapy pool at Water world in Hamilton. They resolved in their Ten Year Plan to provide funding provision of \$180,000 in 2006/07 for the design of a hydrotherapy pool and to contribute 1/3rd of the capital funding to construct the pool. The Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust has taken on the task of raising the community's contribution of \$M1.2 of the cost (\$M2.4). The Trustees are:

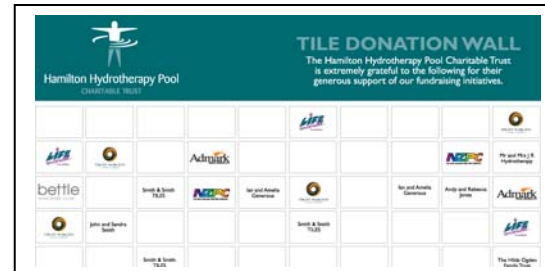

Donation for Tiles



To raise funds to build the hydrotherapy pool, the Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust is seeking donations of \$500 for a tile that will be mounted on the wall in the interior of the hydrotherapy pool building. The tiles will be 10cm high by 15cm long and be made of PVC and their placement will be guaranteed for a minimum of five years. The Tile will be printed with an inscription with the donor's name, be it an individual or company name, and logo in four colour process. A maximum of four tiles can be bought. A total of \$2,000, any larger donation than this will be recognized on a separate donors' board.
