Tile Fundraising Promotion

Is your club or organisation fundraising for a charity, an event, or sports trip?

The Hamilton Hydrotherapy Charitable Trust has a proposition to put to you. We would like to offer you the opportunity to sell tiles on our behalf and thereby raise money for your own project.

To raise funds to build the hydrotherapy pool, the Hamilton Hydrotherapy Pool Charitable Trust is seeking donations of \$500 for a tile that will be mounted on the wall in the interior of the hydrotherapy pool building. The tiles will be 10cm high by 15cm long and be made of PVC and their placement will be guaranteed for a minimum of five years. The Tile will be printed with the donor's name, be it an individual or company name, and logo in four colour process. A maximum of four tiles can be bought. A total of \$2,000, any larger donation than this will be recognized on a separate donors' board

For every tile sold at \$500 each - \$100 commission will be returned to the organisations for their own fundraising initiative.

The Hydrotherapy Trust is aware many sports and service organisations find it difficult into today's climate to fundraise and by taking on this challenge you will achieve it without too much effort. The Trust sees this as a win/win situation with both your organisation and the Trust benefiting.

The Trust has a goal of reaching their target of full funding for the Hydrotherapy Pool by June 2009 and by assisting each other in this way it will help us achieve this by this date.

The sooner the community's share of funds (\$M1.2) is raised the quicker the Hydrotherapy Pool will be built.
