Hydrotherapy contractor announced

Following a two-stage tendering process, Livingstone Building NZ has been awarded the contract to construct Hamilton's first ever hydrotherapy pool. Work began at Waterworld in late February with a ground breaking ceremony and mapping of existing utilities sitting below the pool site. Recently involved in the construction of the Hospice Waikato facility and Te Awamutu's Gracelands Services building, Livingstone works in partnership with an experienced design team. They will bring internationally acclaimed Myrtha Pools technology to the hydrotherapy project, with the proposed design incorporating features like advanced floor technology to ensure a safe rehabilitative surface and different depths catering to a range of users.
